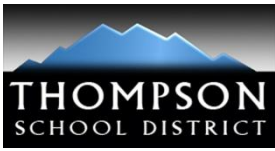


POSITIVE PARTICIPATION CONTRACT

1. Students understand Thompson On Line Campus is a program of choice. Participation and positive attitudes are expected of all students. Students must comply with all instructions, directions, and requests made by staff.
2. Students understand respect forms the basis of all relationships at Thompson On Line Campus. Students must be respectful of other students, staff, guests and local community groups and businesses. Students who fail to do so may lose the option of attending the Thompson Online Campus.
3. Students understand they must actively participate and put forth sincere effort in all classes. Academic performance is evaluated every six weeks. All students enrolled at Thompson Online Campus must agree to abide by the Student and Parent Academic Agreement. Should a student not maintain adequate progress in all classes when 6 week progress reports are completed they understand that they may have to make adjustments to level of instruction, pacing preferences, and lab/teacher support needs. Failure to work collaboratively with the Thompson On Line Campus staff to support adjustments identified above may result in losing the opportunity to continue taking classes at Thompson On Line Campus.
4. Students understand attendance will be strictly monitored. The staff at Thompson Online Campus believes that consistent attendance plays a vital role in student success, not only in school, but for future achievement in the workplace. Good habits now will promote good habits throughout life. Some students may be required to attend the Learning Lab on a regular basis. This is ultimately determined by student performance in conjunction with staff, student, and parent input. All students are expected to work an average of one hour per class, per day and show adequate progress in all of their classes according to their learning plan. Should a student not maintain adequate progress in all classes when 6 week progress reports are completed they understand that they may have to make adjustments to level of instruction, pacing preferences, and lab/teacher support needs. Failure to work collaboratively with the Thompson On Line Campus staff to support adjustments identified above may result in losing the opportunity to continue taking classes at Thompson On Line Campus.
5. Students understand threats and/or intimidation are considered violent behavior. Harassment, making threats, or fighting with other students will not be tolerated. A student may not engage in any conduct that makes another student or staff member feel unsafe in person. This applies to conduct both on and off program grounds as well as electronic communication.
6. Students understand violent behavior of any kind will result in immediate removal and dismissal from Thompson On Line Campus. Depending on the seriousness of the offense, the principal may make a recommendation for expulsion and contact law enforcement authorities. Any student removed from the program because of violent behavior will not be able to re-apply to Thompson On Line Campus.
7. Students understand the possession or use of drugs or alcohol, while on campus or during a program related activity, is not permitted. Students who fail to meet this expectation may lose the option of attending the Thompson Online Campus.
8. The principal may also make a recommendation for expulsion in accordance with Thompson program District policies regarding drug possession and use. In all incidents involving drug or alcohol possession or use, law enforcement authorities will be contacted.
9. Students understand safe driving habits must be adhered to while coming to and leaving the Thompson On Line Campus. Students who demonstrate unsafe driving, or who have complaints of unsafe driving from people in area

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neighborhoods or businesses, may have driving privileges terminated. Depending on the seriousness of the offense, the student may lose the option of attending the Thompson Online Campus.

10. Students understand Thompson School District policies and procedures must be followed at all times. Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner compatible with the program's function as an educational facility.
11. Any behavior considered suspendable in the Thompson program District may lose the option of attending the Thompson Online Campus.
12. Students understand any violation of the Thompson School District Behavioral code of conduct and Board of Education Policies may lose the option of attending the Thompson Online Campus.
