You will need to bring to your appointment proof of residency (e.g., current City of Loveland or Xcel bill), immunization records (with 6th grade booster TDAP shot), birth certificate, previous school records and any legal documentation that the school may need.

REMINDER – All Incoming 6th Grade Students – Please make sure you have received your 6th grade TDAP booster, and all immunizations are up-to-date, before the first day of school.
