



Boys & Girls Club Program @ Truscott Elementary FAQ

How do I enroll my child?

Current Club members need to call Bailey at 970-223-1709 to move their enrollment to the Truscott Site. All additional youth, who are not current Club members, can enroll by stopping at the Boys & Girls Club table at the Back to School Night on August 17th from 5:00-7:00pm. If parents are unable to make this event, there will be additional enrollment opportunities, during the first week of school, hosted by the Boys & Girls Club. ***Please note: spots are limited and will be given out on a first come, first serve basis.***

When do I enroll my child?

Current Loveland Boys & Girls Club members are welcome to enroll their child into this new site. Club members have to be students of Truscott Elementary School to attend. Enrollment for new Club members will open on August 17th (see above for details).

Are there enrollment requirements?

Youth who sign up for this program must attend at least four days per week. Youth who cannot meet this attendance requirement may lose their spot.

How old does my child have to be to enroll?

Grade levels K-5 are welcome to enroll.

How much does the program cost?

There is no cost to this program.

What are the days and times that the program is in session?

The program will run Monday-Friday, 3:10-6:00pm. This program will not operate when school is closed.

Does my child get snack?

Yes, snacks will be provided daily.

What activities will be offered?

The Boys & Girls Club will implement a wide variety of daily activities ranging from; sports, fitness and recreation, art, homework help, STEM learning, character and leadership, and much more. A more detailed schedule will be given out the first week of programming.

When does the program start?

August 27, 2018.

How will my child get to the program?

All Club members will meet daily in the cafeteria once school is dismissed. There, participants will check into the Boys & Girls Club program.
