

Career Academy:

- Graphic Design-12 college credits, one year long program, offered at Aims Loveland campus. Courses include: Adobe Photoshop I and II and Adobe Illustrator I and II.

Concurrent Enrollment:

High School Option-

- Fire Science-12 college credits, one year long program, offered at Berthoud High School. Courses include: Principles of Emergency Services, Fire Prevention, Fire Behavior and Combustion, Building Construction for Fire Protection.
- Criminal Justice-12 college credits, one year long program, offered at Thompson Valley High School. Courses include: Intro to Criminal Justice, Policing Systems, Judicial Functions and Correctional Process.
- College Composition-3 credits, one semester long class, offered at Thompson Valley High School. Must meet test scores requirement to enroll in this course, please see your high school counselor for more details.

What Aims classes can I take?

Students can enroll in classes that are not offered at their home high schools.
